- Providing and maintaining safe equipment and work facilities for the welfare of the employees of Armada and all visitors including course delegates and contract staff.
- Ensuring that, wherever possible, risks and hazards are eliminated or minimised.
- Ensuring safe handling and use of substances when necessary.
- Ensuring that all employees and contract staff who work for Armada are competent to do their tasks, and providing sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to employees and contract staff to enable them to carry out their tasks competently and safely.
- Taking all reasonable steps to prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health.
- Maintaining safe and healthy working conditions.
- Ensuring that visitors or members of the public are safeguarded from potentially hazardous situations.
- Reviewing and revising this policy as necessary at regular intervals
